- Establish schools & collages to provide nursing, paramedical & vocational & basic education.
- 4. Establish & support shelter houses (Panjarapole), hospital & Help line for animals.
- **5.** Relief activities during natural disaster, efforts to preserve the environment, act for rural development & enable the disable.

Strategy:

- 1. No one goes back totally untreated just because he has no money to pay.
- 2. Cure from illness & prevention of diseases is given equal importance.
- 3. In house treatment & out-reach activities go side by side.
- 4. Educate & enable local youth to get job or to be self-employed and
- 5. Provide qualified & skilled nurses & paramedics to medical fraternity.

History:

"Shardaben" a school teacher, had heart attack. Though his son, Dr. Dinesh was a Surgeon in Government Hospital of IDAR she was shifted to Ahmedabad in a critical condition because of lack of proper facilities in IDAR.

- Self-experience of agony of helplessness awakened his dormant feelings to be a bridge between Have & Have not, Needy & Affluent, Rich & poor.
- Dr Dinesh left government job and his parents donated their gratuity and provident fund to establish a charitable hospital which was dedicated to Jain Acharya Vijay Vallbhsuriji, the founder of Shri Mahavir Jain Vidyalaya which provided financial aid (loan) to Dr. Dinesh to be a doctor.
- Having established as a 10 bed surgical clinic on 06-02-1991 in rented building "Atmavallabh Hospital" has grew into a campus having 100 bed multi-specialty hospital affiliated with nursing and paramedical school, by generous support of local farmers and businessman, co-operative units and corporate establishments, social and charitable organizations, national and international NGOs and state and central government.

Our Service Area:


Socio economically backward & tribal districts of Gujarat & Rajasthan (Sabarkantha, Banaskantha, Dungarpur & Banswara & Udaipur) of western India, lying between hills of Arravalli & tributaries of Sabarmati & Mahi river is our service area.

- ➤ More than 75% of population belongs to Schedule Tribes, Schedule class & O.B.C.
- Scanty rainfall & poor irrigation has ruined agriculture. Deforestation, lack of industries & inadequate education has left majority of population unemployed.
 Average per capita income is just ₹ 12000 (250 US\$) per annum.
- Poverty lead malnourishment. Unhygienic living condition & lack of safe drinking water has made this area endemic for all infectious diseases.
- In addition false beliefs, myth, bad habits, wrong traditions and poor health care Services has resulted into very high maternal & infant mortality rate & high frequency of blindness, disability, STDs & cancer in this area.

As all the indicators of social & economical development i.e. Literacy rate, percentage of employment, per capita income, infant & maternal mortality rate is so poor that it is listed among the most backward districts of INDIA!!!

- Centrally located hospital building accommodating 100 patients,
- backed by a building for nursing school providing training to 200 students
- Flanked with hostels for girls & boys and quarters for doctors, faculties & staff.

Three storied hospital building has

- * OPD, Administrative wing, Diagnostic and Emergency unit on ground floor.
- * Five Special, Five Semi-special & Five General wards on First floor
- Four Operation Theatres, post-operative rooms & wards on second floor.

Quality services are rendered without distinction of caste, creed of color by

- Full time: Physician, Surgeon, Gynecologist, Dentist, Eye & Orthopedic Surgeon & M. O. provide equal services to both paying & non paying patients.
- **Visiting**: Pediatrician, Dermatologist, E.N.T-Onco-Uro-Plastic Surgeon, Anesthetist, Radiologist & Pathologist give their services at affordable cost.

In house Diagnostic facilities includes

- Medical section equipped with ECG & Stress test.
- Surgical department equipped with endoscops.
- O Gynecology unit equipped with colposcope.
- O Eye department has two eye chair units, Slit lamp with C.C.T.V. Autorefractometer & A-scan. It has ND Yag laser machine too.
- O Clinical laboratory equipped with Auto analyzer & cell counter.
- Radiology unit equipped with 300 MA X-ray & Ultra-Sound.

Operation theater is our place of worship.

- 3 Operation theaters are equipped with Anaesthetia trolly, Defibrillator, Ventilator Multi-para monitor & C-arm with I.I.T.V. and central Oxygen supply.
- Lt has all necessary instruments for general surgery, gynecological, orthopedic & E.N.T. surgery including microscope, & setup for laproscopic Surgery.
- Two separate eye operation theaters are equipped with operating microscope & Phaco Emulsifier.
- Blood Storage Center is a special features of our hospital.

Everyday nearly 100 patients return home cured.
Every month 300 families greet their dear ones saved.
Every year 1500 operations save the live & relieves pain of people
Every year 2500 persons from pediatric to geriatric age group regain their vision.
Their smiling faces, wet eyes & blessing hands gives us deep satisfaction.


. The institute has manikin, birth simulator, necessary charts & models, audio visual aids, computer lab and other modern gadgets for quality teaching.



Care of sick, poor & disabled is the pivot of our activities.

Health Care:

At Atmavallabh Hospital no one goes back totally untreated just because he has no money to pay. Cure from illness & prevention of diseases is given equal importance.

- Nearly 450000 people are examined, 200000 investigation are carried out, 50000 are treated & 30000 operations are performed in last two decades.
- Medical, Surgical, Gynecology, Eye & Dental services are given either free or at affordable cost to all round the clock.
- All our services are free of cost to BPL. (Rastriya Swasthya Bima Yojana).
- Free general diagnostic camp is a routine activity.
- ♦ We provide free maternity services to BPL women under Chiranjivi Yojana.
- ♦ Our Blood Storage center provides safe blood at any odd hour.
- ♦ 80% of patients get free treatment or subsidy in hospital bills.
- ♦ Hospital provides full diet to patient & their relatives for just 10/- Rs.

Operation theater is our place of worship.

- ★ A team of surgeons perform such a wonderful job that in no time all lumps & bumps weather benign or cancerous are removed,
- ◆ Agony of cut or colic & inflammation or fracture goes away.
- ★ A blind regains vision & a limp start walking erect.

Mobile Medical Unit:

Government of Gujarat selected us to provide primary health care to the most remote villages of Khedbrahma & Vijaynagar taluka by 2 Mobile Medical Units.

- Since 15-01-12 each MMU provides services at fix place on fix day & fix time.
- ❖ It has a team of Doctor, nurse, pharmacist, laboratory technician & social worker.
- Every day one MMU deliver health services to 100 persons free of cost including medicines & laboratory investigation.
- 100 to 120 villages will be benefitted by this project.
- We also provide eye, dental & RCH services by specialist occasionally.

: Eye Care :

Having realized the magnitude of avoidable blindness we established Eye clinic in 1997. It was recognized as Base Hospital in 2002. Our society became a founder member of "Vision 2020: Right to Sight" Gujarat chapter & our Managing trustee Dr. Dinesh was selected as its Founder Trustee in 2005.

We launched project RACE to ensure the Right to Sight to the people of our area.

Achivements:

- 1. Eye examination & Cataract surgery is free for all on every Wednesday.
- 2. We have examined 82271 eyes & conducted 8179 cataract operations free of cost from 2007 to 2011.
- 3. Government appreciated our efforts to prevent blindness every year since 2007.
- 4. Non recurring grant of Rs. 2.5 million was sanctioned by state government under National Program for control of blindness (NPCB) in 2008-09.
- 5. Another 2.5 million rupees were added by our trustees and a well equipped Smt. Shantaben S. Kothari Eye Hospital was inaugurated on 27-01-08.
- 6. State government permitted us to conduct Diploma Ophthalmic Science in 2009.
- 7. A project to examine 100,000 eyes & conduct 12500 cataract operations free of cost in next five years is launched on 15-01-2012.


In these years we realized that

- Sabarkantha district can become cataract free by 2020 but to make districts of Rajasthan Cataract free even by 2030 is a Herculean task.
- Correction of refractory error is generally neglected though it is easy, cheap
 & effective measure to prevent 20% of avoidable blindness especially in youth.
- Deficiency of PMOAs is one major cause of failure to control the blindness.
- Diabetic retinopathy will emerge as major cause of blindness in near future.

So we have decided

- To include correction of refractory error as regular activity in rural camps.
- To extend our services to near by districts of Rajasthan.
- Establish sub centers at suitable places and mobile eye unit for wide coverage.
- To conduct the course of Diploma ophthalmic technology.
- Get prepared to detect & treat Diabetic retinopathy and glaucoma by 2020.













: Nursing, Paramedical & vocational Education :

Skilled & Qualified Nurses & Paramedics are the backbone of Health care. Moreover they are scarce all over the world so to serve medical fraternity & provide employment to local youth we started **Government approved courses.** e.g.

Medical Laboratory Technician (1999) (I.M. A. & Tech. Exam Board of Guj.).

Hospital Assistant & Technician (2007) (Tech. Examination Board of Guj.)

Diploma Ophthalmic Technology (2008) (H&FW Dep.Guj. FOREC-Delhi)

Health Sanitary Inspector (2008) (GCVT & NCVT)

Auxiliary Nurse & Midwife-FHW (2009) (Indian & Gujarat Nursing Council)

General Nursing & Midwifery (2011) (Indian & Gujarat Nursing Council)

We plan to start Vocational Courses like Master in Social Works (MSW) computer Education, Front office assistant, accounting, banking & insurance in near future.

Other Activities:

- We supplied Food & drinking water to the people and grass & water to cattle during famine of 1997, 98, 99 & 2000.
- Medical Aid, Relief material & tents during earthquake of 2001.
- Supplied Relief material in flood affected Kheda & Baroda districts in 2007.
- Distribute clothes to poor & calipers, crutches to needy off and on.
- Organize Artificial Limb, Wheel Chair & Tricycle distribution camp occasionally.
- Our managing trustee is Founder President of Indian Red Cross Society (Idar).
- Our society is active to Stop prenatal sex determination & female feticide, increase awareness against HIV/AIDs & Safe sexual behavior in adolescents & decrease maternal mortality & infant mortality rate.

Future Programs:

- Establish Blood Bank & Diagnostic Center in the hospital.
- ♦ Establish sub centers to implement project SWAMAN to reduce MMR & IMR
- ♦ Tele medicine linkage, Animal Help line and Micro Health Insurance.

From odds to achievements:

When begun our team consisted of only one doctor, five employees, nine trustees and few volunteers but clarity of thought & transparency in action, made more people join our movement & caravan grew.

- 1991-94 diamond merchants of bombay donated to construct hospital building.
- ☐ 1994-95 deciples of Guru Vallabh from N. India & Rajasthan donated for equipments.
- 1995-96 Japan Jain Sangh (Kobe) donated ₹5 Lacs as corpus fund to our chairman.
- ☐ 1997 Mumbai Jain Yuvak Sangh raised ₹ 15 Lacs as corpus fund.
- 1999 & 2001 NRI & NGO of USA donated ₹50 Lacs to Dr. Dinesh during his trip.
- 2004 NRI of Japan, Hongkong, Singapor donated ₹50 Lacs to Dr. Dinesh during his trip.
- 2005-06 deciples of Guru Vallabh donated ₹22 Lacs for free eye operation.
- 2006-07 our own trustees donated ₹60 Lacs to construct new hospital building.
- 2000-07 our own trustees donated to take to construct new nospital building.
- 2008-09 Gove. of Gujarat sanctioned a Grant of ₹25 Lacs to upgrade eye hospital.
- 2010-11 our own trustees donated ₹ 100 Lacs for educational activities.

Today our team includes 10 full time & 20 visiting doctors, 25 paramedics & nursing staff, 12 teaching faculties and sufficient support staff. Moreover we have more than 100 dedicated members, 12 trustees & 32 patrons supported by hundreds of volunteers, well wishers and donors stretched all over the world.

Financial Status:

In 1991 society was established from gratuity & P.F. of a retired teacher couple but continuous flow of selfless support of donors has enriched it. Increase in number of beneficiaries & maximum utilization of resources has helped us to bring our cost of service per beneficiary reasonably low even after paying enough remuneration to our employees. Moreover government aid & voluntary donation has enabled us to provide some of the services either free of cost or at highly subsidized rates.

Today VishvaKalyan society is a self dependent & steadily growing NGO.

Let play of circumstances not allow you to work in such remote area but please extend a part of thyself to strengthen our efforts to make them smile




